Eligibility for Admission to B.Sc. (I.T.)

Student from the following categories will be eligible for admission :

- 1) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science Information Technology, shall have passes XII standard examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subject and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.
- 2) Candidate who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science / Computer Technology / Information Technology / Electrical, Electronics & Video Engineering and Applied Branches / Mathematical and Applied Branches Civil and Applied Branches of Engineering after S.S.C. (Xth Standard) are eligible for direct admission to the second year of B.Sc. I. T. Degree course.

However, Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other Recognized Government Body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.

3) Candidates with post HSC Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science Computer Technology / Information Technology and applied branches will be direct admission to the Second year of B.Sc. (I.T.). However, the Diploma should be recognized Government Body Minimum Marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category candidates and 40% for Reserved Category candidates.

Duration of Course :

The course is full time with six semester spread over three year. It consists of 30 papers with sixth semester specially designed for project work.

 a) Shall have passed Semester I, II, III and IV in full. OR

- b) Shall have passed Semester I and II in full and secured ATKT in the Second year by failing in not more than Two Courses in each Semester III and Semester IV.
- c) Shall have Secured ATKT in First Year by failing in not more than Courses in each of Semester I and Semester II and have passed Semester III and Semester IV in full.
- 2) Eligibility for admission to Semester V (Third year) if UG programs (aided and non-aided) in Faculty of Science is amended as follows, Learner shall have passed Semester I, II, III, IV in full.

VI FEES

- 1) Fees & Deposits for the term must be paid at the time of admission as per the University norms.
- 2) Liability for payment of fees : If a student intends to leave the college in the second term, he/she must intimate to the Principal accordingly in writing at least one week prior to the commencement of the second term. If no such intimation is received the student will be liable to pay the full prescribed fees for the second term.
- 3) Refundable Deposits if NOT CLAIMED by the concerned student WITHIN ONE CALENDAR YEAR from the date on which he/she ceases to be on the roll of the college, WILL LAPSE IPSO FACTO.
- 4) Deposits will not be refunded, if dues of the College, are not cleared by the student, on account of breakage of laboratory equipment, damage done to any college properly, loss of library books etc.
- 5) Original Fees Receipt and identity card must be produced at the time of application for refund of fees.
- 6) Refund of Tuition, development and all other fees after cancellation of admission : The candidate who have taken admission in under graduate courses may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter. - II) The fee charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as university share (including Vice-Chancellor fund, University fee for sports and cultural activities, E-charge, disaster management fund, exam, fee and Enrollment) are non refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation.
- III) Fee Collected for Identify Card and Library Card, admission form and prospectus, enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.
- IV) All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be fully refunded at the time of cancellation.

Provided that wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and / or for any other courses by other competent Authorities, (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admission. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, 0.2859 is applicable for cancellation of admission.

Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses.

Further that 0.2859-A & 0.2859-B have been repealed and the amended 0.2859 relating to the refund of Tuition fees, Development and all over fees after cancellation of admission for the under Graduate Courses has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.

A) Documents required along with Application for Admission
