# **B.Sc. IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY**

## **Eligibility for Admission to B.Sc. (I.T.)**

Student from the following categories will be eligible for admission :

- 1) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science Information Technology, shall have passes XII standard examination of Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subject and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.
- 2) Candidate who have passed Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science / Computer Technology / Information Technology / Electrical, Electronics & Video Engineering and Applied Branches / Mathematical and Applied Branches Civil and Applied Branches of Engineering after S.S.C. (Xth Standard) are eligible for direct admission to the second year of B.Sc. I. T. Degree course.

However, Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other Recognized Government Body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates.

- 3) Candidates with post HSC Diploma in Computer Engineering / Computer Science Computer Technology / Information Technology and applied branches will be direct admission to the Second year of B.Sc. (I.T.). However, the Diploma should be recognized Government Body Minimum Marks required 45% aggregate for Open Category candidates and 40% for Reserved Category candidates.

## **Duration of Course :**

The course is full time with six semester spread over three year. It consists of 30 papers with sixth semester specially designed for project work.

**Eligibility for Admission to all the Under Graduate Programs (Aided and non-aided) in the Faculties of Arts, Science & Commerce under Credit Based Semester and Grading system.**

- 1) Eligibility criteria for a Student, to be admitted in Semester V (Third year) of UG programs (aided and non-aided) in Faculties of Arts and Commerce is amended as follows :
  - a) Shall have passed Semester I, II, III and IV in full.



OR

- b) Shall have passed Semester I and II in full and secured ATKT in the Second year by failing in not more than Two Courses in each Semester III and Semester IV.
  - c) Shall have Secured ATKT in First Year by failing in not more than Courses in each of Semester I and Semester II and have passed Semester III and Semester IV in full.
- 2) Eligibility for admission to Semester V (Third year) if UG programs (aided and non-aided) in Faculty of Science is amended as follows,

## VI FEES

- 1) Fees & Deposits for the term must be paid at the time of admission as per the University norms.
- 2) Liability for payment of fees : If a student intends to leave the college in the second term, he/she must intimate to the Principal accordingly in writing at least one week prior to the commencement of the second term. If no such intimation is received the student will be liable to pay the full prescribed fees for the second term.
- 3) Refundable Deposits if NOT CLAIMED by the concerned student WITHIN ONE CALENDAR YEAR from the date on which he/she ceases to be on the roll of the college, WILL LAPSE IPSO FACTO.
- 4) Deposits will not be refunded, if dues of the College, are not cleared by the student, on account of breakage of laboratory equipment, damage done to any college property, loss of library books etc.
- 5) Original Fees Receipt and identity card must be produced at the time of application for refund of fees.
- 6) Refund of Tuition, development and all other fees after cancellation of admission : The candidate who have taken admission in under graduate courses may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter. The percentage of fee for the course shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges follows :

- II) The fee charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as university share (including Vice-Chancellor fund, University fee for sports and cultural activities, E-charge, disaster management fund, exam, fee and Enrollment) are non refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation.
- III) Fee Collected for Identify Card and Library Card, admission form and prospectus, enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.
- IV) All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be fully refunded at the time of cancellation.

Provided that wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and / or for any other courses by other competent Authorities, (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admission. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, 0.2859 is applicable for cancellation of admission.

Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses.

Further that 0.2859-A & 0.2859-B have been repealed and the amended 0.2859 relating to the refund of Tuition fees, Development and all over fees after cancellation of admission for the under Graduate Courses has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.

## **IX**

### **DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT**

- 2) 50% seats are reserved for Hindi Bhashi Minority students.
- 3) Collect prospectus from office enquiry window.
- 4) Fill up on-line college admission form on college site [www.kmagrawalcollege.org/junior](http://www.kmagrawalcollege.org/junior) through student login and take printout.
- 5) Checking of Admission form with required documents by Admission Committee.
- 6) Submission of Admission form along with Fees, at cash counter. (Counter No. 10)  
On ground floor general office.

#### **A) Documents required along with Application for Admission**

For all admissions, application form should be made through prescribed application form with following documents. The application form should be duly filled and it must reach to the Principal within the stipulated period as notified. The application form must accompany following documents.

- 1) Original Marksheet of the previous qualifying examination along with two Xerox copies (Self attested).
- 2) School Leaving Certificate in original with two Xerox copies (Self attested)
- 3) Xerox copy of Caste Certificate, if admission is being sought for reserved category. (Self attested).
- 4) Original Certificate for Sports / Cultural activities, if admission is being sought under Sports / Cultural category.
- 5) Original copies along with one Xerox copy in case of any other reserved category such as Freedom fighters, Government Job Transfers, Ex-Servicemen, Handicapped etc.
- 6) For reserved category students, only Maharashtra Government Caste Certificate is valid.
- 7) Students must submit the Xerox of Adhar Card along with admission form.

#### **B) Eligibility**

- 1) A student who has passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Board, is eligible for admission to F.Y.J.C. (Std. XI) class.
- 2) A student who has passed the equivalent examination other than conducted by Maharashtra Board will be given provisional admission. All such students will have to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the Divisional Secretary, Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education, Mumbai, Sector 16, Vashi, Navi Mumbai and submit the same to the college office for final admission with in 10 days from the date of admission otherwise admission will be cancelled.

- 3) A student who has passed S.S.C. or equivalent Examination from other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, and not opted for ENGLISH IN THE SAME WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION.
- 4) Admission will be purely on the Merit Basis.

- 7) A student passing Std. X examination from other than Maharashtra State Board should submit mark sheet, passing certificate, transfer certificate with counter signature and migration certificate with in ten days of admission (counter no. 8)

### **C) Status of Admission**

- 1) All admission will be treated as provisional until all the necessary Certificate / Documents such as original Mark Sheets, Final Eligibility Certificate, Transfer Certificate, School Leaving Certificate etc., are submitted and approved by the appropriate authorities.
- 2) No admission will be valid unless it is granted by the authority of the Principal.
- 3) All admissions will be valid only for one academic year (Subject to satisfactory attendance) and will require renewal by application in prescribed form for each subsequent year of the college.
- 4) Admission procedure will be followed as per guidelines of Deputy Director of Education Government of Maharashtra.

### **D) Cancellation of Admission**

- 1) Admission will be cancelled only on receipt of application in the prescribed form (available in the college office) together with original fee receipts, I-card, library card & no-dues certificate for science students.
