From the inception of our college we have been conducting all the Curricular, Co-curricular, extra-curricular and career-oriented activities for the enhancement of students. Our college has completed Third Cycle of NAAC with B++ Grade (CGPA-2.78.)

Curricular:

Student Induction & Orientation:

Faculty & Institutional Development Workshops:

IQAC has organized a One Day Workshop on “**NAAC Reforms**” on 9th December 2025 at 11.30 a.m. in the College Auditorium. The objective of the workshop was to familiarize faculty members and staff with the recent reforms introduced by NAAC and to **enhance institutional preparedness for accreditation.**

Total 29 teachers of the college attended the workshop. Dr. N. S. Dharmadhikari guided the participants on the Ten Attributes of the New NAAC Framework. The e-Certificates were mailed to all the participants.

The IQAC organized a **One Day Workshop on 12th December 2025, on “NEP 2020: Implementation of Digital Initiatives, Uploading Credit Data”.** The workshop

focused on digital reforms, academic bank of credits (ABC), and procedures for uploading student credit data through digital platforms. Hon. Dr. Pravin Shinkar, Nodal Officer (NAD & Samarth Portal), I/C Director Department of Information & Communication

Technology, University of Mumbai guided the staff. Total 30 participants were participated in the Workshop.
